

# 2014 Rotary China Conference



The 2<sup>nd</sup> Rotary China Conference was held on September 20-21, 2014 in Pudong, Shanghai. We were honored to have Rotary International President Huang joining us and giving an inspiring speech on the themes of how to be good citizens, how to extend a good influence on others, how to develop member growth and also elaborating on the theme of his presidency: "Light Up Rotary".

- 1. Is it the truth? 是真的吗? Shì Zhēn de ma?
- 2. Is it Fair to all Concerned? 是公平的吗? Shì Gōng Píng de ma?
- 3. Will it build Goodwill and better Friendships? 是善意的并促进友谊吗? Shì Shàn Yì de - Bìng Cù Jìn Yǒu Yí ma?
- 4. Will it be Beneficial to all Concerned? 是对大家有利吗? Shì Duì Dà Jiā Yǒu Lì ma?

This Rotary China Conference was a truly international Rotary conference as we had district governors, presidents and members of at least 30 international clubs in attendance, including but not limited to Bangladesh, Canada, Hong Kong, Malaysia, Singapore, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Russia and USA. In addition, there were large delegations from the Rotary Clubs in Beijing, Chengdu and obviously Shanghai as well as from Interact and Rotaract clubs in China.

We had many inspirational speakers on the first day of the Conference. Apart from the presentations made by social enterprise leaders, one of the highlights was the speech made by Dr. Cheng Che-Min (aka Zheng Zhemin). Dr. Cheng went to the USA on a Rotary Foundation Scholarship of RI in 1948. Now 90 years of age, he came all the way from Beijing in order to give us an over 40 minute speech on how he obtained the scholarship and how he benefited from the opportunity to achieve an outstanding career in China as a distinguished professor at the Chinese Academy of Sciences. His speech also included many fascinating historical documents from RI in the later 1940s.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> day of the Conference was devoted to Rotary China affairs. China District Representatives, Rotary, Rotaract and Interact club Presidents gave activity updates and future plans. We celebrated the charter of the Rotary Club Chengdu, the certification of the HULT Rotaract Club in Shanghai and of two Interact Clubs in Changhzhou as well as the induction of new members into the Rotary family. Especially to be highlighted are the Paul Harris Fellowships which Gary on this occasion awarded to Dr. Cheg Che-min, John Liu, Dmytro Maksymenko and Simon Maguire. Gary Huang took this opportunity to challenge all of us Rotarians in China, in line with his target to grow the number of Rotarians from 1.2 mio. to 1.3 mio. worldwide, to have 10 Clubs in China by the end of this year and 15 by the end of the Rotarian year.

Despite all speeches and presentations, there were also sufficient occasions to meet and interact. Rotarians and friends enjoyed the Conference dinner in an outdoor environment as well as performances from Nanmo High School Orchestra, Rotarians, spouses and friends.

After the conference, many participants as well as RI President Gary Huang meet for an evening BBQ at Frank's place, as so often generously sponsored by Frank Yih himself.

To summarize, the RI China conference was a resounding success, as acknowledged by the participants and Gary, thanks to the intrepid organizing committee and the great speakers. The international participation (30 clubs, 15 districts) underlines the great interest the refounding of Rotary in China has roused.
